Continuous Learning Schedule

Middle School

We will be following a schedule for online learning in ELA, math, science, social studies, Spanish, and religion to make things more consistent and easier for our families to navigate. At this time the expectation is that students are working every day in ELA and math. Science, social studies, Spanish, and religion teachers are meeting with their classes once per week to check in and explain the weekly assignment which will be due at their next scheduled weekly meeting.

Students will be expected to "attend" class at their scheduled time. This will allow teachers to set up online meetings or use discussion boards in real time. It will also allow students to ask questions as necessary. On Tuesdays and Thursdays ELA and math teachers will be available over Edmodo to respond to students' questions during their posted office hours.
