## Summer Work for Rising Grade 3

### 2021-2022 School Year

Over the summer, all students rising to Grades 1-8 at St. John the Evangelist Catholic School are required to review both ELA and Math skills using the school's IXL (the world's most popular learning site for Kindergarten through Grade 12) subscription. New students will receive their IXL and AR log-in information via email from the school office. Students will complete IXL problems until they achieve a score of 85% or higher.

Choose LEARNING in the green tab across the page top, then MATH or LANGUAGE ARTS, then select GRADE 2 (the grade just completed) from the colored tabs on the left. Please search by skill area instead of by number (as numbers may change). All IXL assignments should be completed between June 14 and August 30, 2021.

To help build fact fluency, rising third graders should practice on [XtraMath.com](https://www.xtramath.com) for 10 minutes 3 days/week. XtraMath.com is a timed 10 minute program and will sign your child out at the end of each session.

The best way to become a stronger reader is to read every day. Summer is a great time to sit back and enjoy a good book. We strongly encourage you to read as often as possible and to choose books that you enjoy.

This summer you will meet your summer Accelerated Reader (AR) goal by **choosing any books of interest on the Accelerated Reader platform**, reading the books, and taking the associated tests. **Goals must be completed by the first day of school.** New rising third graders should earn at least 4 AR points over the summer. Current rising third graders already received their goals from their teacher and can find it again once they log-in. Of course, students may earn more than the required points! Current students will use your regular AR login information to access your account and the tests; new students will be emailed an AR login. The AR testing website will be available Monday – Friday, 8:00 am – 3:00 pm.
