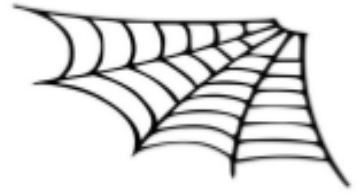

Please include student's name, grade, category, and title of their pumpkin on the email.

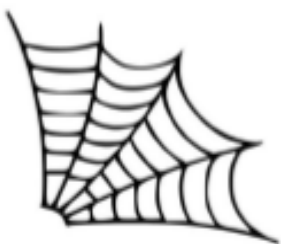
Unfortunately, students can not bring pumpkins to school this year.
