



Dear New Parents,

We are so excited that you have chosen St. John for your child(ren) and look forward to partnering with you on your child's educational journey. I am writing to clarify some things for new parents regarding "Summer Work."

All students in grades K to 8 have a summer assignment. Students rising to grades K and 1 next year have packets to complete:

Students rising to grade 2 have IXL to complete, and students rising to grades 3 to 8 have IXL and Accelerated Reader requirements.

IXL is an Internet-based platform that builds students' skills in language and math. We use IXL throughout the school year to support lessons in the classroom. Teachers have assigned a series of IXL skills for the summer for extra practice. Students work to a SMART SCORE while working through the skills. Each grade level has a required SMART SCORE. The score builds as the student reaches mastery. Below are all the IXL assignments for each grade level. You can get to the website by clicking this link:

Students rising to grades 3 to 8 must-read over the summer and take Accelerated Reader tests. Students should log into the program using this link:

Use the sign-in credentials we sent.

1. Click Accelerated Reader.
2. Search for the book you plan to read to be sure it is on Accelerated Reader (Not EVERY book is on the program. Choose a different book if it is not available).

3. Once you know it is on the program, after you read it, take the **reading practice** quiz associated with it. You can find it when you search for the book.

Every book in A.R. has a point value. Harder/longer books have higher values than smaller/easier books. Every child has a point goal to reach. You can find your goal by clicking “Progress” on the upper right of the home page. Here, you can also track how close you are to your goal. Students must pass the quiz to get points. If your child receives a failing mark, no points will be awarded.
