For your summer reading, students are required to complete one bingo by choosing activities from the Summer Reading Bingo worksheet attached. The bingo can be horizontal, vertical or diagonal. A list of suggested books is also attached to help you complete your Bingo worksheet.

Students will also work on individualized IXL Diagnostic Recommended skills this summer. Each IXL skill is to be completed to 85% or 20 minutes.

See the attached document for how to find the IXL Recommended skills and how to PRINT out the student's plan.

Students should document their Summer Reading as well as IXLs on the printed out Diagnostic Plan for both Math and Reading. All documented work should be signed by a parent and brought to school when the student returns in August.

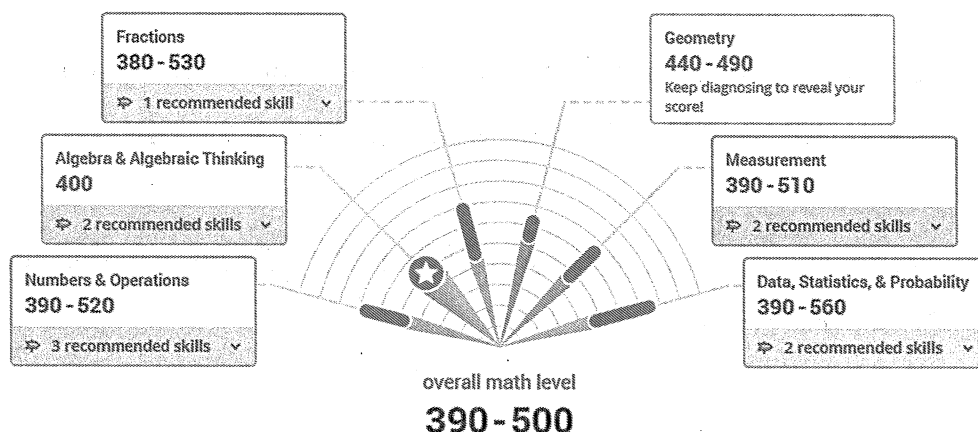
IXL Diagnostic Skills Instructions

Step 3) Click on a skill level to practice.





