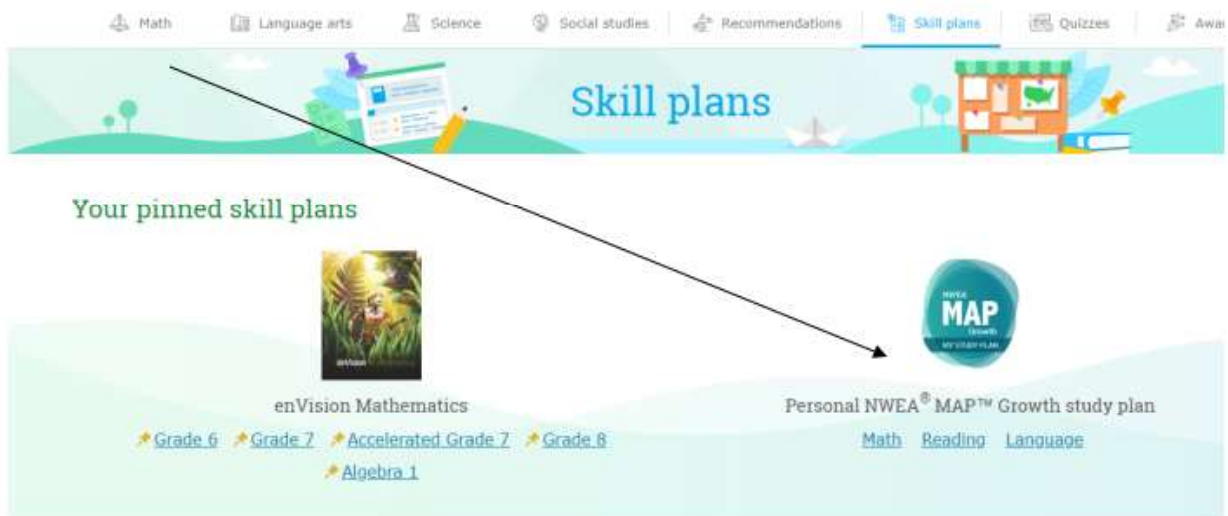
## IXL MAP Skills Instructions

Step 1) Log into IXL

Step 3) On the right-hand side under NWEA MAP, select the subject area.



Step 4) View your list of suggested skills. For ELA, please select 1 IXL from each category. i.e. 1 skill from each of the following categories; *Reading: Literary Text, Reading: Informational Text, Reading: Vocabulary, Language: Grammar, Language: Mechanics, Language: Writing*. Each IXL should be completed to 90% or 20 minutes. DO NOT choose IXLs previously completed in the school year.
