
#### **IXL Diagnostic Skills Instructions**

#### **Incoming Grade 4 Book Report**

Students entering grade 4 should choose a chapter book that they have not read before. This book should be at least a third grade level book. Please use the website ARbookfind.com to check if your book has an AR test, and to check the reading level. After reading this book:

### After reading this book:

- 1. Complete the attached paper "My Book Report Poster."
- 2. Choose one of the following activities:
  - a. On a piece of blank paper, design a new book cover for your book.

    This should include the book title, author, and your own illustrations.
  - b. Design a poster to advertise your book. Your poster should include the book title, author, your own illustrations, and reasons why someone might want to read this book. This should be completed on a piece of poster board.
  - c. Write a book review. This should be at least one paragraph (5-6 sentences) explaining your opinion of the book. Be sure to include if you would recommend this book to other students.
- 3. Be ready to take an AR test on this book when you return to school.

### Math note for incoming 4th graders:

Mastery of both multiplication and division facts is necessary for success in fourth grade math. Therefore, students should spend time over the summer weeks reviewing these facts. Resources such as flash cards, as well as websites and games used throughout the school year can be used over the summer to review facts. Consistent and frequent review throughout the summer is strongly recommended!!
