See the attached document for how to find the IXL Recommended skills and how to PRINT out the student's plan.

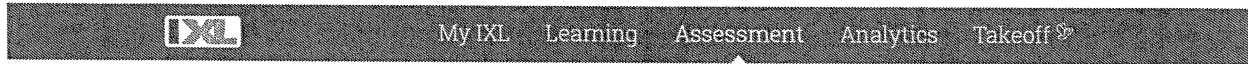

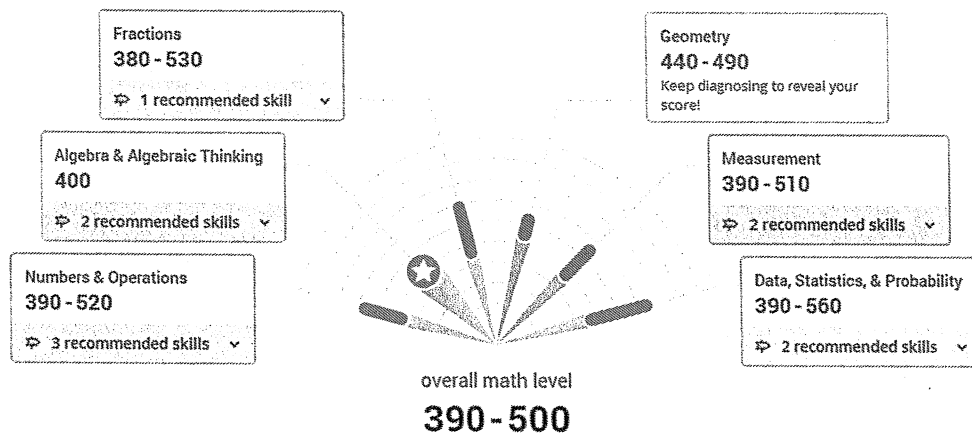
## IXL Diagnostic Skills Instructions

## Google Slides Book Report

### Instructions:

1. Choose a novel from the list of six choices.
2. Once you have finished reading the novel, use the Graphic Organizer below to write notes preparing for each slide.
3. You will need 6 slides containing the following information:
  - Slide 1 - Your name, book title, author, illustrator, genre
  - Slide 2 - Describe the main characters using physical and personality traits/ descriptions
  - Slide 3 - Setting description. Write a description of where and when the story takes place.
  - Slide 4 - Story Plot (problem) - write about the most important problem in the story.
  - Slide 5 - Conclusion or Plot Resolution - write about how the problem was resolved/ solved in the book.
  - Slide 6 - Book recommendations. Write your opinion of the book - if you would recommend this book or not, give 2 reasons.

**You will present this slideshow to the class the first week of school.**

### Slide Requirements:

1. Please make sure your slides all have a solid background and use colors pleasing to the eye.
2. Include clipart/ pictures per slide to represent as much of your book as possible.
3. Choose a font style that is easily read - sizes 12, 14, 16
4. Write in complete sentences.
5. Use correct spelling and grammar.
