Room Parent Committee

Operates during the school year

The Committee consists of Room Parents who operate throughout the school year. There are two parents per grade, starting at PreK 3 through 8th grade. Hospitality Committee

Operates during the school year

Committee members will plan special moments for teachers, faculty, staff, parents, and grandparents throughout the year. Moments have included Stock the Fridge, Cookie Walk, and Lemonade Bar. The Committee also provides refreshments for several events for parents and grandparents. Our small moments still have a big impact! We are always open to new ideas - join us to learn more. The Chairperson meets with their committee before each event and will manage volunteers and resources.

Hot Lunch Committee
